

THE NEW GASOMETER AT CORK.

A NEW gasometer has just been completed for the Cork Gas Consumers' Company. It is 154 feet in diameter, by 25 feet in depth, and this additional storage power will enable the company to keep half a million cubic feet of gas in addition to their present supply. The plans were furnished by Mr. Anderson, the engineer to the company, and the works carried out by Mr. Still to the entire satisfaction of the directors. The occasion of the finishing of the monster gasholder was taken advantage of as a fitting opportunity for a *reunion* of the shareholders and the employés. For this purpose the capacious interior of the gasometer was tastefully decked out, and an elegant luncheon served within its iron walls. The services of a number of amateur musicians; who played several fine pieces, added greatly to the proceedings. - The workmen employed were entertained in the evening, when they sat down to an excellent and substantial dinner within the gasholder.
