

## CORK DISTRICT LUNATIC ASYLUM.

SINCE we last recorded the misunderstandings between the board and Mr. Atkins, the architect, the latter has resigned, having accepted an offer of a sum of money in addition to his fees of 2½ per cent. Mr. Atkins's resignation and the death of Mr. O.C. Edwards, C.E., having created a vacancy, the board advertised that they would, at their meeting on the 21st ult., appoint an architect to carry out the proposed works. There were several applications, but no appointment was made, owing to there being a tie between Mr. William H. Hill and Mr. S. Kirkby, Cantab., County Surveyor. The board have since advertised that they would make the appointment at their next general meeting on Friday the 4th inst.
