

Letter from Colonial Land Emigration Office  
 of Park Street Westminster 23 January 1849  
 Stating that her Majesty's Government having  
 decided on granting free passage to New  
 South Wales to families of certain persons  
 transported to that Colony and that Bridget  
 Smith of Dunsinaghlin is one of those entitled  
 But requiring an outfit of Six Shirts Six  
 pair of Stockings two pair of Shoes two  
 complete Suits of exterior clothing one  
 pair of sheets and three towels for the  
 male persons, Six Shirts two flannel  
 petticoats Six pair of Stockings two pair  
 of Shoes two gowns one pair of Sheets  
 and three towels & for females  
 Moved that the clerk write to the Poor  
 Law Commissioners to know can this Board  
 give an outfit to Bridget Smith as above
